  - A separate space shall be provided where outpatients change from street clothing and gown, clothing storage, convenient to the imaging rooms.
- Provide a staff toilet, internal to the service space, if three or more procedure rooms.
- Handwashing stations shall be located within the unit
- Self-contained medicine-dispensing unit shall be provided for locked storage of medications and drugs. The location of a self-contained medicine-dispensing unit shall be permitted in the clean workroom or at the administrative center or nurses' station, provided there is adequate security for medications and adequate lighting to easily identify drugs. Convenient access to handwashing fixture shall be provided.
