Los Angeles County Public Works intends to issue an Invitation for Bids (IFB) to award a construction contract for the Generator Building Project Component of the Harbor-UCLA Medical Center Replacement Program.

The proposed project consists of the construction of a new stand-alone approximately 1,000 square-foot 12 kilovolt distribution switchgear building, including underground infrastructure and equipment modernization, and Nonstructural Performance Category-5 Upgrade of the campus existing 12 kilovolt generators building.
