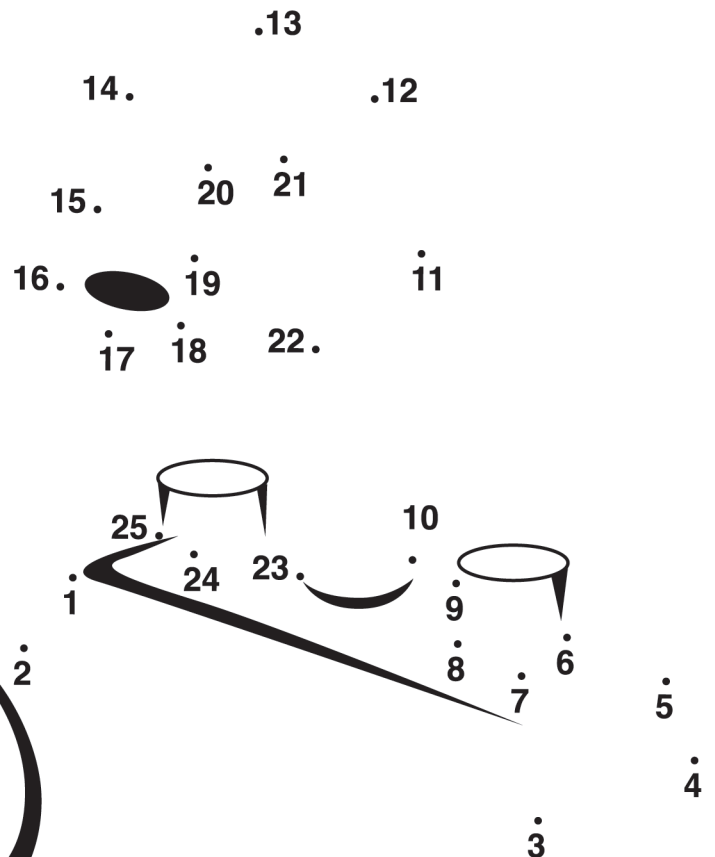
SAVING WATER

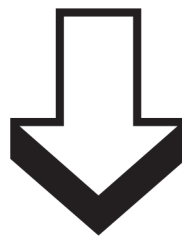

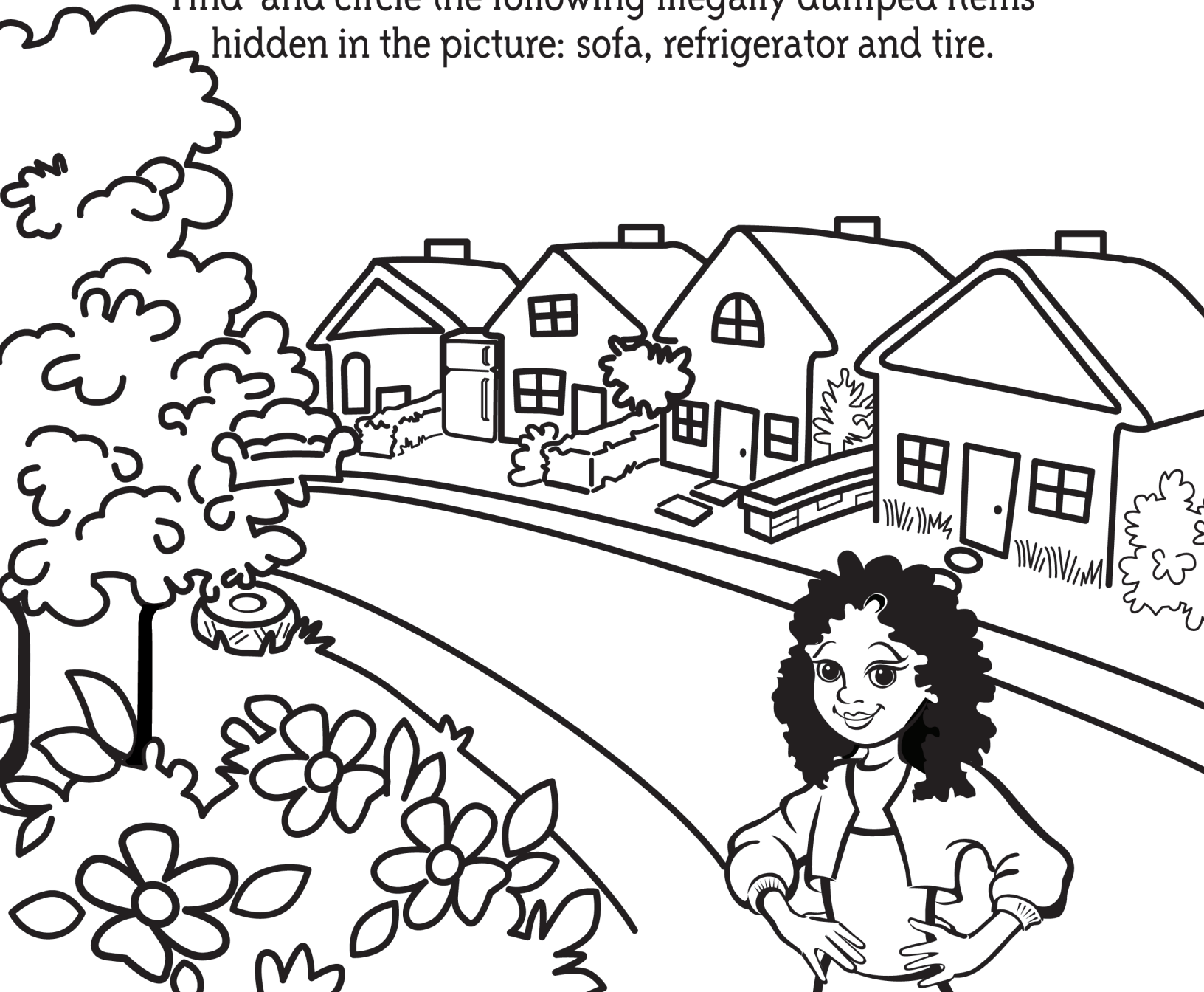

ILLEGAL DUMPING

Household hazardous waste (HHW) is any leftover product with a "poison," "toxic" or "flammable" warning label. HHW will harm the environment if it is poured on the ground or put in the trash.

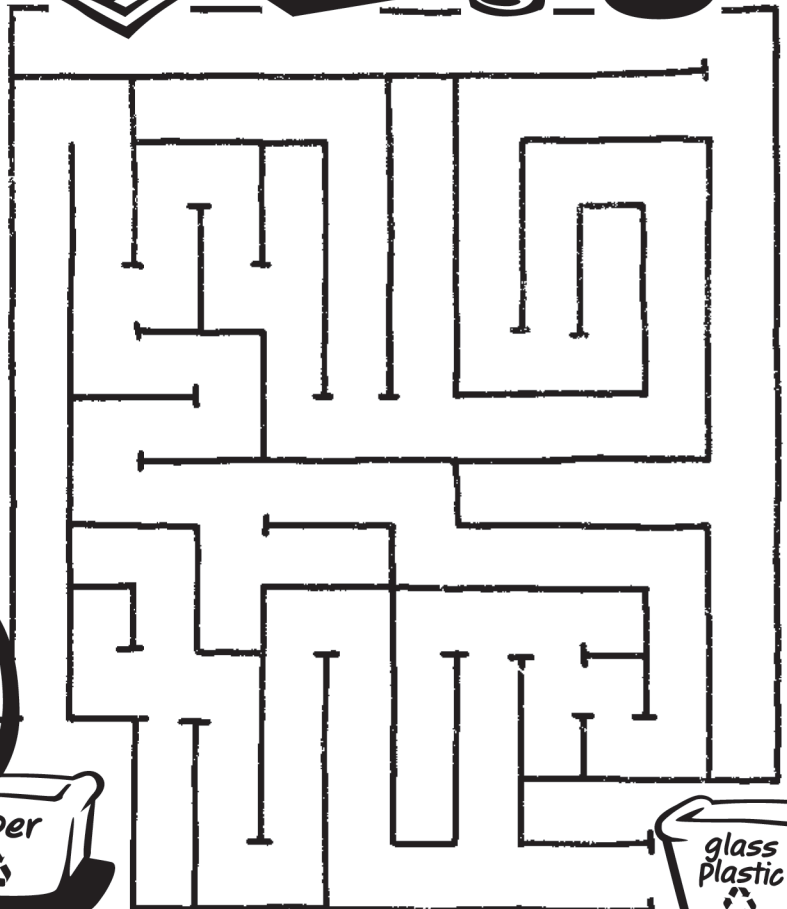

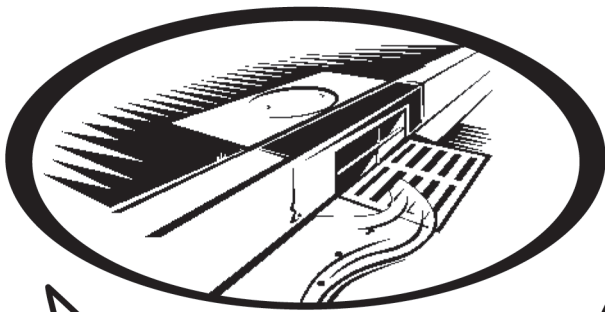


STORMWATER POLLUTION
