Attention Licensed Food Facility Operators,

In Accordance with the previously noticed *July 1st, 2009 Grease / Solvent Waste Management Initiative*, Network Piping Monitoring Systems (NPS) is pleased to announce its participation as your service monitoring provider. As part of this green project, beginning in January of 2010, we have or will be placing the required "MP Grease T678 monitoring unit" at your location. **This device is paid for by your governments' stimulus package.** The initiative requires all licensed food related facilities equipped with a 3 compartment sink, Prep sink, mop sink, or combination thereof to enroll in the monitoring program prior to August 30, 2010. The activation as well as the nominal yearly monitoring fee is attached. Businesses utilizing a "hand sink" only are exempt from the requirement.

The MP GI T678 electronic device is a detection (level 4) unit that monitors grease & solvent discharge in the main artery prior to entering the underground waste/piping systems which lead to treatment plants and ultimately to our oceans. These systematically placed devices report noncompliant levels of contamination of underground waste (F.O.G.) systems. NPS issues detailed findings both to your company as well as local Hazardous Response Units in the event of a major spill or accidental non-compliant discharge. If during a six month period, NPS registers two failed test readings, your company as well as The Environmental Health Office will be notified.

The MP GI T678 electronic device also represents a viable deterrent for illegal dumping and detection of non compliant use of direct grease or solvent waste lines. Sampler boxes on underground grease interceptors used previously to determine levels of discharge do not meet the threshold of full compliance. The interceptor must possess a registered, electric, tamper proof monitoring unit in the out take line (such as the MP-T678). Grease Traps or other under counter sink models also fail to comply with the Directive unless they also possess a registered, electric, tamper proof monitoring unit.

Upon receipt of your paid invoice, you will be issued an access code to our website as well as a state registered emblem which is to be prominently displayed next to or in close proximity to your food establishments' active facility license.

NPS is committed to this preventive green initiative and to the environment as a whole. As part of our program, **free test strips are available upon request.**
