FINDING OF CONFORMANCE
SUNSHINE CANYON SANITARY LANDFILL EXPANSION
COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES UNINCORPORATED AREA

By correspondence dated May 13, 1991, and subsequent amendments, the Los Angeles County Solid Waste Management Committee/Integrated Waste Management Task Force received a written request from Ms. Brenda Theveny, from the law firm of Brobeck, Phleger & Harrison, representing the project proponent, Browning-Ferris Industries, to grant a Finding of Conformance for the subject facility. The Task Force reviewed the proposal for conformance with the Los Angeles County Solid Waste Management Plan.

In accordance with Section 50000 of the California Public Resources Code, the Task Force hereby submits its Finding of Conformance with the CoSWMP for the Sunshine Canyon Sanitary Landfill Expansion. This Finding was approved on August 15, 1991, by 8 yes votes and 3 abstentions of the members of the Task Force present when the vote was taken.


On March 12, 1986, the California Waste Management Board approved the CoSWMP, Triennial Review, Volume I, Nonhazardous Element, dated March 1984, and Revision A, dated August 1985. The Finding of Conformance was granted in accordance with the requirements of said document.

FINDING OF CONFORMANCE—SUNSHINE CANYON LANDFILL EXPANSION

On April 17, 2003, the Los Angeles County Solid Waste Management Committee/Integrated Waste Management Task Force granted a Finding of Conformance for the proposed expansion of the Sunshine Canyon Landfill Phase I of the City Landfill Unit 2. The Task Force reviewed the material presented for conformance with the Los Angeles County Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 10 of the Los Angeles County Countywide Siting Element. The Siting Element requires that new and expansion of existing solid waste disposal facilities be consistent with the Siting Element. The California Integrated Waste Management Board approved the ColWMP on June 23, 1999.


The enclosed FOC was approved on April 17, 2003, by eight "yes" votes, two opposed votes, and one abstention of the members of the Task Force present when the vote was taken. It is the opinion of the Task Force that granting this FOC will not impair or impede solid waste diversion activities in the County of Los Angeles.
