CALRECYCLE'S INITIAL DISCUSSION DRAFT REGULATORY REVISIONS TO TITLE 14

- On July 3, 2012 CalRecycle released it's Draft Language for Discussion.
- Issue #3 – On-site storage and 12,500 cubic yard limit.
- On Aug 9, 2012 staff sent a letter to CalRecycle on behalf of Task Force.

COMMENTS REGARDING CALRECYCLE'S INITIAL DISCUSSION DRAFT REGULATORY REVISIONS TO TITLE 14

- Redefine agricultural material and green material to have a uniform meaning among other regulatory agencies.
- Include standardized requirements for review and approval by the EA.

COMMENTS REGARDING CALRECYCLE'S INITIAL DISCUSSION DRAFT REGULATORY REVISIONS TO TITLE 14

- Section 17856 - Agricultural Material and Green Material Composting Operations and Facilities
- These Facilities should not be allowed to be located within a quarter-mile radius of neighboring residents, schools and the immobile population.
- Add Subsection.

SWRCB's INITIAL DISCUSSION DRAFT REGULATORY REVISIONS TO TITLE 23 & 27

- On Aug 7, 2012 the SWRCB released a draft Order detailing the proposed requirements for compost facilities.
- Public workshop on Aug. 28th (Riverside, CA)
- Staff will prepare a draft letter addressing all comments following the workshop.

SWRCB's INITIAL DISCUSSION DRAFT REGULATORY REVISIONS TO TITLE 23 & 27

- Formal comments will be accepted until Sept 12, 2012.
- This order will be voted upon for adoption by SWRCB during their October board meeting.
