NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND PUBLIC MEETING – TENTATIVE ORDER TO TERMINATE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGE OF NON-HAZARDOUS CONTAMINATED SOILS AND OTHER WASTES TO CLASS III LANDFILLS

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will consider a tentative order for the termination of General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 91-93 that was adopted on July 22, 1991, for the discharge of non-hazardous contaminated soil and other similar wastes to properly engineered and managed waste management units.
