
California's climate change targets





2022 Scoping Plan -Short Lived Climate Pollutants

SB 1383 requires CARB to adopt and begin implementing the Short-Lived Climate Pollutant (SLCP) Reduction Strategy

In 2017, CARB approved and began implementing the comprehensive SLCP Reduction Strategy to reduce statewide emissions to below 2013 levels by 2030 for:


- methane by 40%
- hydrofluorocarbon gases by 40%, and
- anthropogenic black carbon by 50%


State GHG Emissions 2013

State Methane Emissions - 2013




Decomposition of organic waste in landfills accounted for 21% of statewide methane emissions in 2019
