Good Morning,

AQMD issued the attached violation yesterday (1/6/22) for alleged odor complaints that occurred on January 3, 2022.

We were informed that there were 13 verified odor complaints between approximately 6:30 and 9:40 am. Three additional calls came in later that morning but were not verified.

Since receiving these complaints, we have continued to implement aggressive odor management protocols for the remainder of this week as we work around challenging wind/weather conditions. There is a lot of activity onsite, but we have not lost focus on odor abatement. The team is still highly engaged in the odor monitoring programs, including a full, dedicated odor patrol team every day.



The landfill received the last heavy rain on 12/30/2021. The exposed trash left from

some of the drained ponds in the northwestern County part of the landfill were not covered by the end of this inspection period.

The operator must take immediate action to prevent further rill erosion on the side slopes and erosion of the landfill cover.

27 CCR 20650 - Grading of Fill Surfaces

Covered surfaces of the disposal area shall be graded to promote lateral runoff of precipitation and to prevent ponding. Grades shall be established of sufficient slopes to account for future settlement of the fill surface.

The landfill received the last heavy rain on 12/30/2021. The operator had been pumping out the ponds and reducing their sizes. However, ponding continues to be observed in the northwestern County part of the landfill over the filled areas. The operator was instructed to pump out all of the ponded areas as soon as possible and re-grade the area to divert the runoff away from the disposal area as soon as it is safe to do so.

The covered surfaces of the disposal area must be graded to promote lateral runoff of precipitation and of sufficient slopes to prevent water accumulation and/or infiltration into any filled areas.

Inspection Report Comments

This report is a compilation of the SCL-LEA staff observations for the period of 01/22/2022 to 01/28/2022.

Area of concerns continue to be noted for exposure of waste and ponding on site.

Weather conditions were fair with a few windy days during this observation period.

One working face was in use in the bottom CC4-Part 4A area. The alternative daily covers were effective in covering up all waste at the end of the day's operation.

The spotters were directing traffic.

The operator was reminded to keep up with the removal of the accumulated litter on site. Litter pickers were collecting windblown litter on site. No windblown litter was observed to be leaving through the front of the landfill as of this observation period.

The portable water-atomizing cannons were in use. Misters were also in use on the perimeter fences and along the haul road for odor control.

The water trucks and sweepers were in use for dust control.

The bird control measures were in place to control the birds.

The load checks were conducted during this observation period.

The lining of the next cell, adjacent to cell CC4-Part 4A, continued during this observation period. The lining work did not interfere with the normal traffic flow as of this observation period.
