2) New Guidance for Landfill's under SB 1383

- a) The <u>Landfill Guidance: Organic Disposal Reduction Status Impact Report (SIR)</u>
 <u>Overview</u> has been updated to help provide clarification on the suggested guidance to address each item of the SIR, per 27 CCR Section 21695(c)(1) (c)(13).
 - i) This document is available under the Landfill and Disposal Sites section of the LEA Regulation Implementation Guidance webpage.
 - ii) As a friendly reminder, landfill operators must submit their Status Impact Report (SIR) to CalRecycle by January 1, 2023. The SIR may be sent to CalRecycle via email at permittrainingassistance@calrecycle.ca.gov.

The Used Mattress Recovery and Recycling Act requires the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to review and update as necessary, the mattress stewardship program baselines and goals every four years beginning July 1, 2020 (by July 1, 2024).

The purpose of this workshop is to review the baselines and goals and solicit public comments and input for consideration as part of the review process and potential

Background

The Used Mattress Recovery and Recycling Act required the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to establish, in consultation with the mattress recycling organization, the state mattress recycling baseline amount and the state mattress recycling goals by January 1, 2018. CalRecycle reviewed and updated the baselines and goals in 2020.
