2) **New Guidance for Landfill's under SB 1383**

- a) The [Landfill Guidance: Organic Disposal Reduction Status Impact Report \(SIR\) Overview](#) has been updated to help provide clarification on the suggested guidance to address each item of the SIR, per 27 CCR Section 21695(c)(1) – (c)(13).

BCRP Operational Guidelines for New Beverage Containers

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) will be holding an informational webinar virtually on Tuesday, October 24, 2023 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm designed to provide you with information on the operational requirements for the new beverage containers that were added by SB 1013 (Atkins, Chapter 610, Statutes of 2022) and SB 353 (Dodd, Chapter 868, Statutes of 2023) effective January 1, 2024. The webinar will offer information for Beverage Manufacturers, Distributors, Beverage Dealers, Recycling Centers, and Processors on how to report, assess California Refund Value, and accept/handle the new containers

Public Meeting Notice: AB 1201 (Ting, Chapter 504, Statutes of 2021) Public Workshop

CalRecycle will hold a public workshop on November 1, 2023, to solicit public feedback regarding the feasibility of collecting products that are not acceptable compost feedstocks under the National Organic Program (NOP) separately from organic wastes that are acceptable under the National Organic Program as described in Section 42357(g)(1)(B) to the Public Resources Code (PRC).

CalRecycle has developed a discussion paper that will be discussed during the workshop. The discussion paper presents the data that CalRecycle has compiled to help determine if it would be feasible to collect and process products that are not acceptable under the NOP separately from other organic waste. Interested parties that have additional data should provide that data during the workshop or via email at Organics@CalRecycle.ca.gov by November 8, 2023.
