❖ The legislature will **reconvene on April 10th**

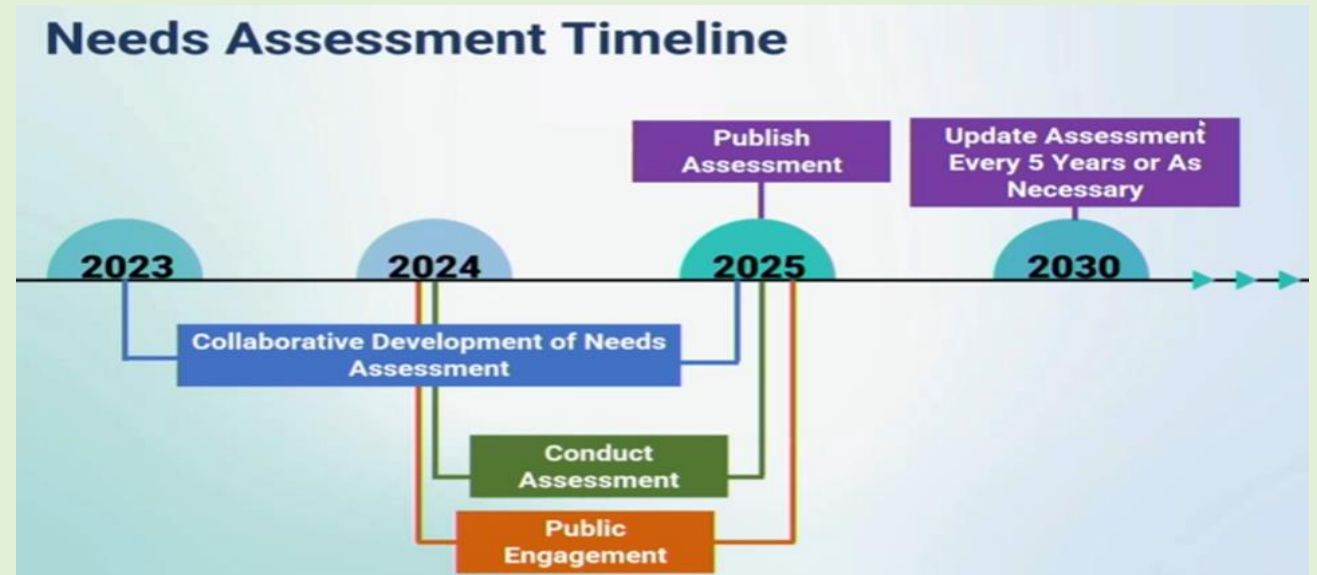
❖ **April 28** is the last day for policy committees to hear and pass fiscal bills



SB 54 Update

Overview of the Advisory Board and the Needs Assessment

- CalRecycle is now accepting [applications](#) for the Advisory Board members and has set the submission deadline for **Friday, March 24, 2023**.
- This new advisory board for SB 54 will have [10 voting and 3 non-voting members](#).



Legislative Update

- **Recommending to consider *Support In Concept***
 - **SB 560 – Solid waste: extended producer responsibility.**



- ***Watch Bills* for consideration**
 - **AB 1526 – Solid waste: plastic pollution: architectural paint.**
 - **SB 707 – Responsible Textile Recovery Act of 2023.**

Senate Bill 560 – Solid waste: extended producer responsibility.

- Establishes a framework for the application of extended producer responsibility to the end-of-life management of covered gas cylinders, which include propane gas cylinders under 20 pounds, helium cylinders, isobutane cylinders, and butane cylinders
- Recommending ***Support In Concept***



Assembly Bill 1526 – Solid waste: plastic pollution: architectural paint.

- Makes technical amendments and other revisions to certain components of the Plastic Pollution Prevention and Packaging Producer Responsibility Act (SB 54, Allen, 2022),
- Revises Act's definitions and a PRO's producer fee schedule.
- Updates the existing Paint Stewardship Program by eliminating the exemption from the program of aerosol spray paint and would provide that architectural paint includes aerosol coating products
- Recommending a ***Watch***



Senate Bill 707 – Responsible Textile Recovery Act of 2023.

- Enacts the Responsible Textile Recovery Act of 2023, which would require producers, either individually or through the creation of one or more stewardship organizations, to establish a stewardship program for the collection and recycling of covered textiles.
- Recommending a ***Watch***
