

# APPLICABILITY OF FOC

**“Significant Change”** refers to changes in the design or operation of a disposal facility such as: (1) an increase in maximum amount of permitted tonnage of all waste received on a daily basis or during another time period; (2) an increase in the facility’s permitted acreage; (3) an increase in the permitted hours of operation; and (4) for landfills, an increase in permitted volume (airspace) or quantity (tonnage), disposal footprint, permitted (final grade) or maximum overall elevation.

Typically, these changes may require: (a) compliance with the requirements of CEQA; (b) issuance or modification of a facility’s land use permit/conditional use permit, and/or Waste Discharge Requirements; (c) issuance of a Revised Solid Waste Facility Permit.
