



APPLICABILITY OF FOC

- ✓ Solid waste disposal facilities (e.g., Class III landfills, inert waste landfills, and alternative technology facilities)
- ✓ New and existing or expansion of existing solid waste disposal facilities which institute a "significant change" to their operation





PURPOSE

Finding of Conformance:

- Provides a mechanism for the inclusion of new solid waste disposal facilities and/or expansions of existing solid waste disposal facilities into the Countywide Siting Element (CSE)
- Ensures that the Siting Criteria of the CSE are applied consistently
- Provides a public forum to review each individual project





REGULATORY FRAMEWORK



PRC Section 50001


- Solid waste facility is identified in the CSE
- Prepare and submit a site identification and description to the Local Task Force

CCR, Title 14, Section 18756

 Satisfy the minimum siting criteria that are adopted in the CSE




FINDING OF CONFORMANCE (FOC) PROCESS (Prior to issuance of SWFP)



TYPICAL FOC REQUIREMENTS Routine Submittals

- Types of reports as required by FOC
 - Semi-annual waste characterization report
 - Quarterly Disposal Quantity report
