1) **Monthly SB 1383 Chat with CalRecycle**

2) **New Guidance for Landfill's under SB 1383**

- a) The [Landfill Guidance: Organic Disposal Reduction Status Impact Report \(SIR\) Overview](#) has been updated to help provide clarification on the suggested guidance to address each item of the SIR, per 27 CCR Section 21695(c)(1) – (c)(13).

 - ii) As a friendly reminder, landfill operators were to have submitted their Status Impact Report (SIR) to CalRecycle by January 1, 2023. The SIR may be sent to CalRecycle via email at permittrainingassistance@calrecycle.ca.gov.
