Per Capita Disposal

- Per capita disposal (PPD) measurement system (Wiggins, [SB 1016](#)) makes the process of goal measurement as established by AB 939 simpler, more timely, and more accurate.
- Uses two factors:
 - 1) a jurisdiction's population (or in some cases employment)
 - 2) a jurisdiction's disposal as reported by disposal facilities
- CalRecycle uses per capita disposal as an indicator in evaluating program implementation and local jurisdiction performance.
