Transit Pass Subsidy Program For Unincorporated Area Residents

Eligibility Requirements:

Unincorporated County residents who are Seniors (62 and older), those with disabilities, students (kindergarten through 12th grade), or attending College/Vocational school are eligible to participate in the County's Transit Pass Subsidy Program with Metro. Discounted Metro monthly passes and EZ transit monthly passes are also available to unincorporated County residents who reside in the First, Second, Fourth, and Fifth Supervisorial Districts.

Getting Your Subsidized Metro Pass:

The first step in acquiring your subsidized Metro pass is to obtain age and residency certification. To get certified, go to one of the following Metro Customer Center locations, fill out a certification application, and provide additional documentation (see below).

Once you have your eligibility certification form, you may purchase your monthly pass at any of the Metro Customer Centers listed above or at any of the approved pass retail locations shown below.

Type of ID Required for Eligibility:

A photo identification and proof of residency are required along with the certification application. Acceptable forms of proof of residency include: current utility bill, credit card bill, or bank statement with name and address on it, current property tax bill, current vehicle registration, or correspondence from a student's school addressed to the student. Proof of eligibility varies by category. For seniors, 62 years or older, a Medicare card or Department of Motor Vehicles driver's license/ID or Metro Senior ID card is needed. A Los Angeles County Transit Operators Association card is required for persons with disabilities, and a Metro student fare card or Metro college/vocational ID card is required for students.
