

IC/ID Implementation Plan

The City of Maywood proposes to follow the IC/ID program as stated in the Los Angeles County SQMP. Implementation will include the available forces including the Los Angeles County Sewer Maintenance District Personnel, county Road Department Personnel and City field staff along with the public at large.

The City of Maywood Maintains a Citizens complaint process for a wide variety of issues, with Illicit Discharges being one of the areas covered. When a complaint is received at City Hall in person or by Telephone the complaint form is routed to the appropriate department and a staff member is dispatched to investigate the complaint.

1. If the staff member identifies the discharge as exempt under the permit, notes are made to that effect and the person complaining is notified of the results of the investigation.
2. If the complaint is found to be active, the staff attempts to identify the source and nature of the discharge, attempts to contain the flow and cause the stopping of the flow. The property owner is then notified of the violation and is told to desist any further discharge.
3. If the discharge is determined to be an unknown nature the City will notify the County Hazmat to assure that proper safety measures are taken. Once the case is turned over to the Hazmat team, Los Angeles County Fire, their incident commander handles all further response.
