IRWM Plan Standards	Basic Update	Full Update
Region Description	Add water quality conditions	Analyze current regional conditions
Plan Objectives	Incorporate new objective requirements	Reevaluate all existing objectives
Resources Management Strategies (RMS)	Incorporate RMS from 2013 CA Water Plan	No additional updates
Project Review Process	Update existing project list	Review projects and selection processes
Plan Performance and Monitoring	Contain policies and procedures that promote adaptive management	Adjust all existing performance and monitoring processes
Local Water Planning	SW Resources Plan*; include adaptive water management	SW Resources Plan*
Local Land Use Planning	Demonstrate collaboration with local planning agencies	Review and expand collaboration as needed

- Address arsenic, perchlorate, and hexavalent contamination
- Update nitrate contamination





Plan Objectives

- Adapt to changes in runoff and recharge
- Analyze energy consumption and GHG emission reductions in water use
- Include strategies in AB 32 Scoping Plan
- Consider carbon sequestration and renewable energy options






Resources Management Strategies (RMS)

- Include additional 2013 California Water Plan RMS
- Factor climate change effects





Project Review Process

- Review project list
- Update submittal form to include detailed items to be reviewed during project review process





Plan Performance and Monitoring

- Ensure proper project monitoring
- Confirm compliance with all applicable rules, laws and permit requirements





Local Water Planning

- Develop a Stormwater Resources Plan for stormwater and dry weather runoff capture projects
- Incorporate water management issues and climate change adaptation and mitigation strategies from local plans





Land Use Planning

 Demonstrate information sharing and collaboration with regional land use planning





Climate Change

- Determine the feasibility for the RWMG to address the priority vulnerabilities
- Consider effects of sea level rise on water supply conditions (including imported water) and identify adaptation methods
