





Prop. 1 IRWM Implementation Grant PSP – Updates

Final draft released April 22, 2019

| Topic | Draft PSP | Final PSP |
|---------------------------|---|---|
| Project scoring: DAC | No points for benefits to DAC | 1 point if project provides minimum 75% benefit(s) to DAC |
| CEQA Completion | Within 6 months of final grant award | Within 1 year of final grant award |
| Pre-application workshop | Required | Optional; preapplication materials required |
| DAC project qualification | 100% of benefits in a DAC area | 75% of benefits in a DAC area |
| Admin. Costs | n/a | Limited to 10% |
| DWR feedback | Within 4 weeks of the pre-application submittal | Within 6 weeks of the pre-application submittal |
| Final app. deadline | Within 12 weeks of DWR feedback | Within 8 weeks of DWR feedback |
| Climate change | No attachment required | Climate change attachment required |

 - Led by representatives from each IRWM RWMG, applying entities, local project sponsors, DAC, EDAs, and Tribes
- Present overall proposal and each Project

Full AV IRWMP Update

- Water Supply and Demand Projections
 - Exploring new methods
 - Potential supply source update: imported water + groundwater + surface water + recycled water
- Data sources
 - UWMPs
 - Watermaster
 - Department of Finance population projections for Kern, Los Angeles, and San Bernardino counties
