INFORMATION NEEDED TO INITIATE PRELIMINARY REVIEW OF PROJECT

The following items are required for the Waterworks District to perform a preliminary review of your project:

- Information Sheet and Application (form WW172) and Fixture Unit Determination Chart (form WW174).
- Water Demand Summary of the Project (form WW190).
- Fire Department requirements shown on development plan (Tract Map, Parcel Map, Site Plan, etc.) with original approval.
- Planning Department requirements (Conditions of Approval).
- For Subdivisions – a plan showing the phases of development, as applicable. For single lots – a plot plan (including fronting street(s)).

The Waterworks District will perform a preliminary review only after all of the above items are received. The preliminary review will include a hydraulic analysis conducted by the District. The results of which will be provided for facility design purposes and/or determination of public fire flow availability. The developer's engineer must then perform his own hydraulic analysis to size the facilities needed to meet the on-site demands.

An agreement statement will not be issued until the review is completed and final requirements are set. The developer must then hire a professional engineer registered in the State of California to prepare the water system improvement plans.
