Water System Infrastructure Community Meeting



An aging water supply infrastructure and undersized pipes are challenges that face Malibu and Topanga residents. Your Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 29 invites you to attend one of three community meetings to hear about the planning effort to address these deficiencies.

Waterworks District No. 29 supplies water to more than 7,000 homes and businesses. Some sections of the water delivery system are undersized and provide insufficient fire flow capability to existing homes and businesses. Moreover, frequent leaks are costly to repair and make service less reliable in some areas of the District. Based on available funding and current water rates, the District proposes to build critical projects to provide a more reliable system. The proposed improvements will only include those that address existing deficiencies.
