Coastline Drive Waterline Improvements

Los Angeles County Public Works is committed to fostering vibrant and resilient communities and supporting community wellness by providing reliable, high-quality water to Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts customers. Public Works is finalizing the design for a replacement waterline in your neighborhood.


The Coastline Drive Waterline project consists of replacing approximately 2,000 feet of an aging waterline along Coastline Drive between Pacific Coast Highway and Castlerock Road, located in the Sunset Mesa community. The new waterline will reduce the risk of leaks and improve water supply reliability for the local community.

Project construction is planned between Spring 2025 and Spring 2026. Construction will take place Monday through Friday, between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Traffic access will be maintained throughout the project limits using temporarily restricted lanes.

The Sunset Mesa Tank site (see project limits map) will serve as a staging area for all construction operations including delivery and storage of construction materials/equipment and preparation of waterlines for installation. Work within the staging area is planned between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
